

Frequently Asked Questions

Are school transfers selected by lottery?

Each transfer application is reviewed and granted on its own merits

Can a transfer be revoked?

A student transfer can be revoked in cases of truancy, discipline issues, excessive tardiness or absences or falsification of enrollment information.

Is there a chance in the future that Sweeny ISD will not have open enrollment?

What will happen to my child?

In the unlikely event that the district changes its policy, out-of-district students who are enrolled at the time will be allowed to stay until they complete high school.

What about transportation?

No transportation is provided.

Is after-school child care available?

Tuition-based after-school child care is available at the elementary school and junior high until 6 p.m. each school day.

What about extra-curricular activities and sports?

Out-of-district transfer students can participate in all curricular and co-curricular activities and organizations. They are eligible for UIL competition in accordance with applicable UIL rules.
